

REPORT ON CLEAN-UP EXERCISE CONDUCTED

The Saboba district community foundation as part of its programme of activities for 2022 organized a clean-up exercise in collaboration with chiefs in some selected communities on 2nd April 2022.

The objective of the exercise is to help reduce the prevalent of deceases related to unhygienic conditions. It was also to inculcate in the citizenry the culture of disposing rubbish through appropriate means.

Letters were written to some 11 selected community chiefs informing them to beat gong-gong for their subjects to come out in their numbers for the exercise.

To make the exercise more effective a community was randomly selected, (Gbagbanpong) where the executives of the foundation went and participated in the clean-up exercise. Other communities were also encouraged to send pictures/videos of the exercise to the foundation.

In all the foundation had 54% achievement of the objectives. Because more than half the number of communities selected did the exercise.
